Sports Betting Fast Facts





States plus DC have legalized sports betting.



76 million Americans, or nearly **1 in 3** adults, can place a legal sports bet in their home states. Illinois, Michigan, Montana, Colorado, and Washington, D.C. have all gone live in 2020.

Americans have legally wagered nearly \$22.5 billion on sports nationwide since the Supreme Court overturned PASPA, generating more than \$200 million in tax revenue to state and local governments.



In 2019, more than **\$13 billion** was legally wagered on sports, almost double the equivalent total from 2018.



Before the COVID-19 shutdown, 2020 looked set to become another record-breaking year for sports betting with \$3.5 billion legally wagered in January and Feburary, up from \$1.9 billion the same time last year.
