Sports Betting

Authorized Operators: Since New Hampshire does not have any casinos, retail and mobile sports betting in the state will be granted to certain New Hampshire Lottery Commission (NHLC) agents across the state. NHLC may engage up to ten retail agents and five agents to assist them with their mobile/online operations.

Mobile/Online: No requirement for in-person registration. In-play wagering is only allowed through mobile.

Operator Taxes & Fees: NHLC will select from the group of bidders the agents whose bids provide the state with the highest percentage of revenue from the sports wagering.

Amateur Restrictions: Wagering is prohibited on NH collegiate teams and any collegiate game taking place in the state, except for multi-site tournaments that include games that are played in-state and out-of-state (e.g., March Madness).

Official Data Mandate & Integrity Fee: New Hampshire law does not mandate the use of official league data or provide an integrity fee to sports leagues.
