ILLEGAL SPORTS BETTING IS WIDESPREAD...

Americans wagered with illegal, offshore websites and bookies in 2022—*more than half the size of the legal, regulated marketplace.*

ILLEGAL SPORTS BETTING RAISES YOUR TAX BILL...

\$1.75B

 generated in legal sports betting taxes in 2022.

Every tax dollar diverted from the legal market to illegal, offshore operators is a dollar taken away from activities that generate taxes for education, public safety or responsible gaming efforts.

...AND CONTRIBUTES TO CRIMINAL ACTIVITY.

\$3.8B

 in illegal sports betting revenue.
