AGA 2025 FEDERAL PRIORITIES

- Support member tribe gaming priorities in Congress and within the Administration.
- Develop champions by educating policymakers about gaming's positive economic impact and commitment to responsibility.
- Encourage investment through sound tax policy, and advance reforms to enhance industry competitiveness:
 - » Oppose new mandates and other policy changes that would negatively impact tribal gaming operations.
 - » Raise IRS slot tax reporting threshold to account for inflation.
 - » Repeal federal sports betting excise tax.
- Spur enforcement action from DOJ and FBI against illegal gaming, including illegal offshore sports betting and unregulated gaming machines.
